



Top 10 Headlines from the Village Survey on Use of the Pavilion

1. **Community support for improving or extending the Pavilion.**
2. **Accessibility is the biggest barrier to increased use** – lack of parking, poor paths and winter boggy ground repeatedly highlighted.
3. **Demand for more flexible, multi-use community space within the village**, especially for children, teens and social activities.
4. **Significant interest in new facilities.** These are some of the suggestions: youth club, fitness classes, snooker/pool, and gardening club.
5. **Call for better provision for women and girls' sport**, including improved changing facilities.
6. **Residents question the viability of proposed clubs and activities** given existing spaces like the Village Hall and church.
7. **Concerns raised about potential impact on the recreation ground**, including noise, increased traffic, and damage to green space.
8. **Mixed views on evening use**, with some referencing dark-skies policy and lighting challenges.
9. **Requests for clarity on funding, business planning and long-term sustainability** of any extension or new building.
10. **Many endorse the idea of a refreshed community hub**, recognising that a well-designed, accessible space could benefit the whole village.
